General Rules

1. All exhibitors must have adequate public liability insurance
2. It is the exhibitors responsibility to check if the show is still taking place due to bad weather.
3. The organiser reserve the right to refuse any entry.
4. The organiser reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate any classes.
5. No responsibilities will be accepted by the organiser for accidents or damage to riders, competitors, spectators, owners or animals or any other property.
6. The decision of the judge is final.
7. Hard hats must be worn at all times when mounted or handling horses.
8. Any **objections** or protest must be made in writing to the secretary accompanied by a fee of £25 which may be forfeited to the show funds in the event of the objection being over ruled.
9. No litter is to be left on the show ground. CLEANING OUT OF HORSEBOXES AND TRAILERS IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN.
10. Under no circumstances is any animal to be exhibited under a judge who is know to have bred, leased, sold or produced that animal.
11. All grooms entering the ring must be correctly dressed and must wear a hat in the ring.
12. Heritage Section. 1st prize money will only be given if there are six entries or more.
13. Lead Rein competitors must be aged 3 and over.
14. In the Lead rein sections the lead rein must be fixed to the nose band.
15. In Lead Rein snaffle bits only.
16. No tying up on trailers and wagons.
17. Whips not to exceed 75cms (30inc)
18. Competitors to carry passports at all times.
19. Due to **vehicle (4 ton axle) weight restrictions** on the show ground please can we ask all competitors, where possible, to arrive in a 4x4 and trailer or 3.5 ton horse box. Vehicles which appear to be overweight will be weighed and may be turned away.
20. The organisers retain the right to ask any rider to dismount if they are considered too heavy for the horse or pony being ridden.
21. **BSPS** classes competitors will need to wear suitable hard hats as specified in our rule 45
22. May I remind everyone to please to please travel your horse/pony with their passport, it's the law.

Horses and ponies are not to come onto the field if their flu injections are not up to date. Only horses and ponies who receive their yearly booster or horses/ponies who are restarting (must be 7days or more after their 2nd injection) will be permitted onto the show field. We may ask to see their passport to check their vaccination record.

Working Equitation

There will be a Working Equitation demonstration by Tamzin Cowens with two Spanish Horses in the main ring at 10:30am (not confirmed time). Tamzin will talk through how to ride each obstacle with a novice horse and will then demonstrate the 'speed' round with a more experienced horse.

The Working Equitation obstacles will then be placed in ring 1 when the classes finish for the day. You are welcome to take your horse around the obstacles and have a go at your leisure. The obstacles should be completed in walk until you and your horse are confident, and then have a go in trot and canter! Tamzin is a qualified instructress who regularly teaches working equitation and will be available for help and instruction if required.

The 'have a go' working equitation will be £10 per horse, there is no time limit on how long you stay in the ring.

This is a rare and unique opportunity for you and your horse to watch and take part in working equitation, we encourage riders who would like to have a go at this fun sport to get involved. Working equitation increases the trust between horse and rider as the horse needs to be willing to go past his comfort zone and willingly complete the different various obstacles.

BSPS Black Country Saddles Best Rider – The best rider in Open Heritage Lead Rein, Open Heritage First Ridden and Open Heritage Ridden, riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January 2019.

Riders will be awarded a best rider card and qualify for the final at the Summer Championship Show.

BSPS Classic Services Group Challenge. Animals qualify for the challenge by attending any BSPS affiliated show and competing in the appropriate classes, heritage lead rein, first ridden and heritage ridden. Ponies must not have qualified for the 2019 Horse of the Year Show.

TSR Showing Finals - This show is a qualifier for the 2019 TSR Showing Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR Riders Finals - 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification flyer in the ring.

TSR In Hand Finals - The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at <https://www.theshowingregister.co.uk/>

TSR Medal Awards - TSR members can collect qualification flyers & signatures and redeem for a TSR Medal see TSR website for details.
